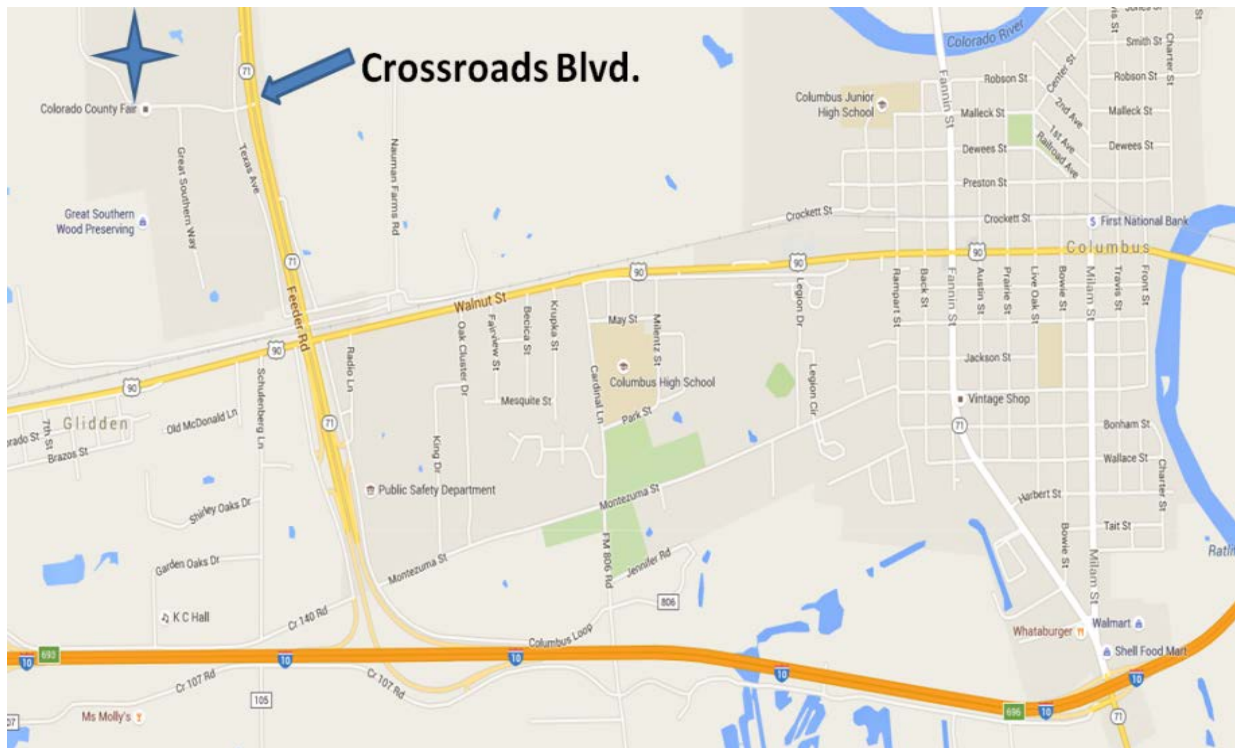

From Austin County:

Start out following FM949 W and 1-10W. From I-10, take exit 695 onto Hwy 71 West. In approximately 2 miles, turn left onto Crossroads Blvd. Follow Crossroads Blvd until you see the fairgrounds and the Exhibit Hall.

From Fayette County:

Get on TX-71 E. as if driving to Columbus. Drive approximately 24 miles. Soon after crossing over the Colorado River, turn right onto Crossroads Blvd. Follow Crossroads Blvd until you see the fairgrounds and the Exhibit Hall.

From Washington County:

Start out taking FM109 South. You will travel through Industry, New Ulm, and Frelsburg. Approximately 11 miles from Frelsburg, FM109 intersects Bus. Hwy 71; turn right onto Business 71. Take business 71 until it intersects with TX 71. Go under the overpass and turn left to enter TX 71 East. In one mile you will cross the Colorado River. Soon after crossing over the Colorado River, turn right onto Crossroads Blvd. Follow Crossroads Blvd until you see the fairgrounds and the Exhibit Hall.
