-hunter/chaperone will set up tents after sighting in guns

-Kids will pick their deer stands they will hunt out of on Saturday morning

Landowners to pick up hunter/chaperone

Saturday morning 5:00am - 5:30am in deer stands by 6:00 am

Saturday afternoon 3:00pm in deer stands by 3:30 pm pick up 30 minutes after sunset

Sunday morning 5:00am - 5:30am in deer stands by 6:00 am

Landowners to give the hunter/chaperone their phone number so that they can call them once they have killed deer/pig to be picked up

Hunters/chaperone to weigh/check-in their kill at weigh station then taken over to the cleaning station after each hunt. Hunters/Chaperone are to participate in cleaning their kill.

Breakfast/Supper will be served and ready to eat between hunts Saturday and Sunday morning and Saturday evening provided by ORWMA.

Sunday: Group Picture with the hunters, chaperone and Hunt Masters and gifts given to hunters.

Gift Cards will be handed out for the following:

1st place heaviest deer

2nd place heaviest deer

1st place heaviest pig

2nd place heaviest pig
